2.00 Terrie Pollard, *When we were young*

Inspired by her husband's memories of growing up in poverty in Ireland, Terrie set out to discover how people around Sheffield coped in earlier decades. Her interviewees had to be over 70 and she asked them about the first 20 years of their lives. The result was the book *Once we were young: in their own words: recollections of Kentish residents*, which was published in 2017.
